## REGISTRATION

**NEW STUDENTS** must provide immunization records prior to attending school. All kindergarten students must have had three required Hepatitis B vaccinations, DTap/Td/Tdap, Polio, Varicella (or healthcare provider verified child had disease) and their second MMR shot. All sixth graders must also have had a second MMR shot and have completed their Hepatitis B series, DTap/Td/Tdap, Polio and Varicella vaccine before school starts. School officials are required to deny admission to those students who are not properly immunized. The registrar's office, located in the Administration Building, is open Monday-Friday, 7:30AM to 4:00PM.

Students enrolling in KINDERGARTEN must have proof of date of birth either by birth certificate or other official document and bring Immunization Records and Parenting plans if any. Kindergarten students must be five years old and first grade students must be six before September 1.

**All ELEMENTARY** class lists are available in each building. Supply letters were mailed but are available in each office and on our website.

**JUNIOR HIGH** student schedules will be available on the first day of school. Supply lists were mailed out and are available in the office or on our website.

**HIGH SCHOOL** student schedules will be available one day before school starts. General supply lists are available at the school or on our website.

**SENTINEL TECH ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL** registration is by appointment only. Contact the Sentinel Tech office at 932-3133 or the high school office at 932-4477 to register. Classes will begin August 28th.

## LATE START MONDAYS

Late Start schedules will be on Mondays of those school weeks with five (5) days of school. School will begin one hour late on those Mondays to give staff time to address needs regarding student learning. Buses will arrive on their scheduled routes one hour later and the breakfast schedules will change on those days. Students who walk, drive, or are driven to school should also arrive one hour later. School will end at the regular time.

## KINDERGARTEN

All kindergarten students attend school for a full day beginning on the first day of school, August 28th. If you have not registered your kinder-aged student, please do so prior to the start of school. Kinder students are asked to bring an extra pair of clothes to have on hand at school.

## TRANSPORTATION

Welcome back!! We have some big changes to share for this new school year. Our morning routes will stay the same K-12. The afterschool routes will now be junior high and High school on the bus and will leave at 2:55 to begin routes home. The elementary schools will leave the school at 3:10 to begin route home. The older students will be home before the elementary students for those who care for younger children. We will have the new routes posted at each building by August 17. For you to view. Please notice that there will be an AM and PM route. **REMINDER-** that students need to be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the bus arrives. We are on a time schedule and waiting is not included. If you have a kindergarten or preschool parent or designated person must be at the bus stop, we will not release them from the bus and they will be returned to school for you to pick up. **REMINDER** that changes must be made before 2 pm or no change will be accepted, we cannot guarantee that the change will make it to the teacher or transportation in time. Best practice is 24 hours in advance. For questions concerning bus service for new students or relocated students, please call 932-4082. **FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY**, please talk to your children about pedestrian safety, cross the street at crosswalk sites and use designated walking routes. Designated walking routes are available at each school and on our website.

## SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAMS

The school lunch and breakfast programs are available to all students beginning the first day of school. There will be no charge for lunches and breakfasts served to Wahluké SD students. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 to 8:00 am at the K-5 schools and from 7:30 to 7:50 am at the 6-12 schools. For those bringing their lunches and wanting to purchase Milk, it will be available for \$.50.

## DRESS CODE

The Wahluké School District requires a uniform dress code for all students during

school and at school-sponsored events. The code specifies certain styles and colors of shirts, slacks, pants, shorts, and skirts/dresses. Coats and backpacks with red or blue are not allowed. Details are available at each school and on our website.

\*A Family Pass admits all family members except junior high and high school students and graduates to all home games. Family Passes may be purchased at the high school office. PE Uniforms are required for all 6-12th grade students enrolled in PE classes. They are available for purchase at the Jr. High -\$15.00, High School for \$12.00.

## STUDENT INSURANCE PLANS

All students who participate in sports must purchase an approved student insurance program or provide evidence of being insured. The District has made available affordable plans through a private company, Meyers-Stevens & Toohey. Plans include school time only, football plans, dental plans, student life plans, and more. Most plans have preferred, economy or budget options. Information will be sent home with students or parents may pick up insurance application forms at their child's school office.

## INTERSCHOLASTIC SPORTS

Students who wish to participate in interscholastic sports must meet certain requirements prior to participating in either practices or competitions. Some of the requirements include:  
1. Submit completed Parent Authorization forms. All parent authorization forms are done online at <http://wahluké-wa.finalforms.com> - Please call your athletes school office for questions  
2. Submit evidence of physical examination (signed by a physician). Sport physicals need to be turned into the office of the school your athlete will be attending.  
3. Be enrolled in school & academically eligible  
4. Provide evidence of insurance. There is school insurance available to purchase. See the school secretary for more information.  
5. Purchase an ASB card. HS ASB: \$35 - JH ASB: \$20 for JH events only - \$30 for JH & HS events.
