



### INCLEMENT WEATHER REMINDERS

As we prepare for the possibility of snowy conditions starting now and through the rest of winter, here are a few reminders for our families:

- **Buses may be delayed returning students home.** Our buses are prepared for snowy conditions and drivers receive training on how to drive in adverse weather conditions. Making sure that students return home safely will be our top priority. Thank you in advance for your patience in the event of delays.
- **The district does not send students home early because it is snowing.** Many of our families do not have an adult who can be home early to provide supervision for the child(ren). We support a parent's or guardian's decision to pick their child up early or to not send their child to school. Absences will be considered excused with a signed note.
- **Afternoon and evening activities may be cancelled.** The decision whether to cancel after-school activities will be made as early in the afternoon as possible.
- **School delays and cancellations-** Road conditions in the district can vary depending on where you live. Our district makes the decision to delay or cancel school based on if we believe the buses can safely transport children. We support a parent's or guardian's decision to pick their child up early or to not send their child to school. Absences will be considered excused with a signed note.

If school is delayed or cancelled due to inclement weather, every effort is made to make the decision by 6 a.m. If conditions change after the decision is made to delay school, it is possible that the district may cancel school. We will try to make a final decision by 7:30 a.m., or shortly thereafter. If a decision is changed, an updated alert will be sent out as soon as possible.

**If there is no mention on the district website of delays or closures, schools are running on time.**
